





And they departed and went through the villages, preaching the gospel and healing everywhere... On their return the apostles told him all that they had done.”





Luke 10:1-11, 17-20 (ESV) - After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them on ahead of him, two by two, into every town and place where he himself was about to go. And he said to them, “The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest. Go your way; behold, I am sending you out as lambs in the midst of wolves. Carry no money bag, no knapsack, no sandals, and greet no one on the road.


Luke 10:1-11, 17-20 (ESV) cont'd.

Whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace be to this house!' And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest upon him. But if not, it will return to you. And remain in the same house, eating and drinking what they provide, for the laborer deserves his wages. Do not go from house to house. Whenever you enter a town and they receive you, eat what is set before you.




Luke 10:1-11, 17-20 (ESV) cont'd.


Luke 10:17-20 (ESV)
